NUTRITION

RDP partners with whom we work most frequently on nutrition, health, food security & livelihood, and WASH

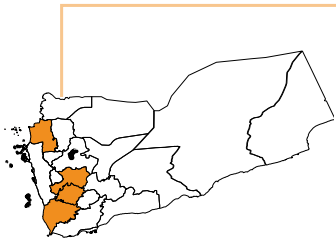

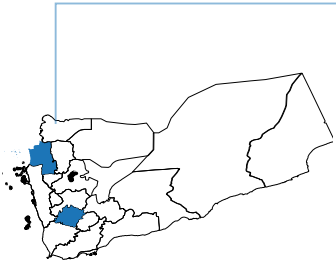
RDP, by the generous support of WFP, continues to distribute nutritional supplements to a number of 48,999 children under 2 and 99,396 PLW to prevent the chronic and acute malnutrition in 11 targeted districts (Far Al Udayn, Al Udayn, Hazm Al Udayn, Mudhaykhirah, Al Qafr, Sama, As Silw, Shara'b Ar Rawnah, Shara'b As Salam, Khayran Al Muharraq, Mustaba, and Washhah) of Ibb, Taizz and Hajjah governorates. RDP also has conducted 8,793 awareness-raising sessions to promote appropriate feeding for infants and young children which help increase their chances of survival as well as optimal growth, reaching almost 131,904 of population.



RDP continues to treat moderately acutely malnourished children and PLW by supporting 17 health facilities with TSFP services. A total of 1,543 children under five disaggregated as (727 boys, 816 girls) and a number of 1,604 PLW disaggregated as (972 pregnant, 632 lactating) received therapeutic supplements (Plumpy Sup & WSB+) to help reduce child mortality in Sama & As Silw districts of Taizz governorate. In addition, RDP raised awareness among community members on health and nutrition key messages, reaching more than 650 pregnant and lactating women.

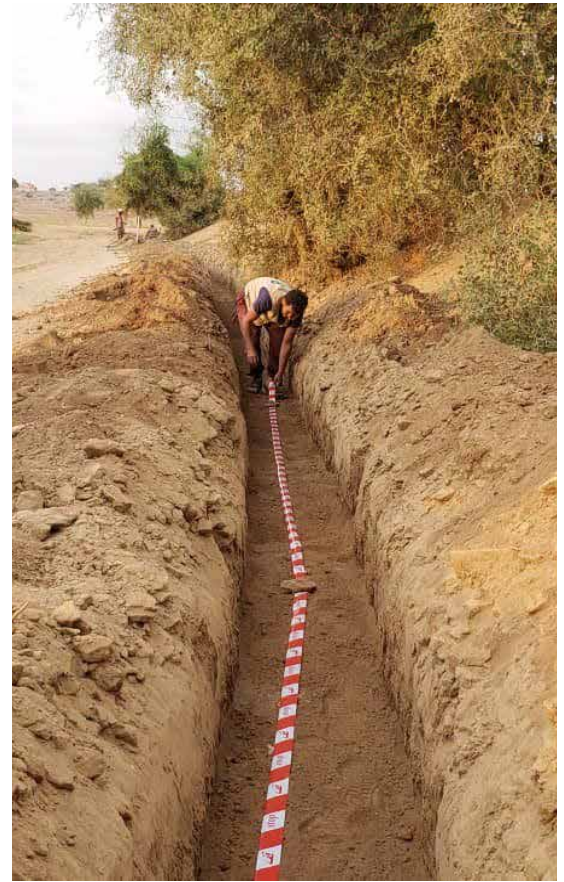

RDP commenced the rehabilitation works for (Luj Al-Kudafa and Al-Hanani) water schemes in response to the water needs which IDPs and most affected population suffer from throughout their daily life, achieving a total of 20% per cent of rehabilitation works within the WASH emergency response project in IDPs collective sites in Kua’ydinah district of Hajjah governorate and Dhi As Sufal district of Ibb governorate, funded by YHF. Besides, our team distributed consumable hygiene kits (provided by UNICEF) to 1,120 HHs of IDPs in Bani Nashar Sub-district of Kua’ydinah district to ensure best practices among the community.

In Dhi As Sufal district of Ibb governorate, RDP conducted a training workshop for community volunteers on community mobilization, delivery of messages on hygiene awareness and improving hygiene practices within the WASH emergency response project in IDPs collective sites. Twenty community volunteers (15 Men and 5 Women) were trained on hygiene promotion and community engagement to strengthen knowledge and facilitate the adoption of behavior.
