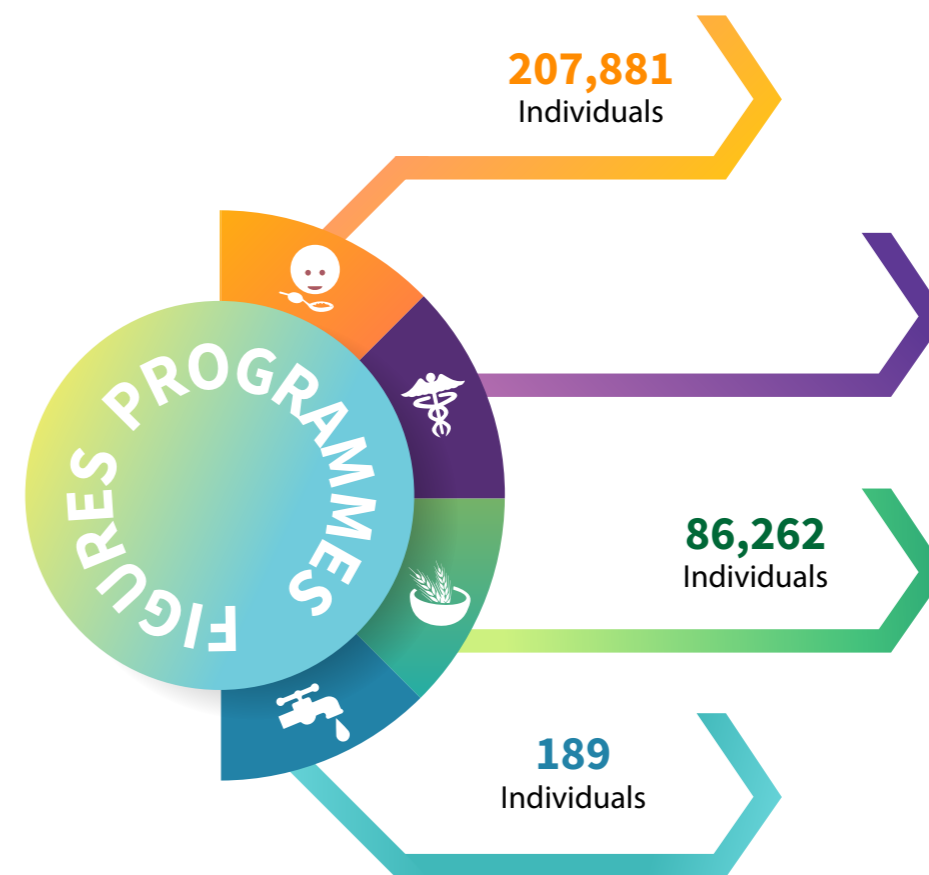

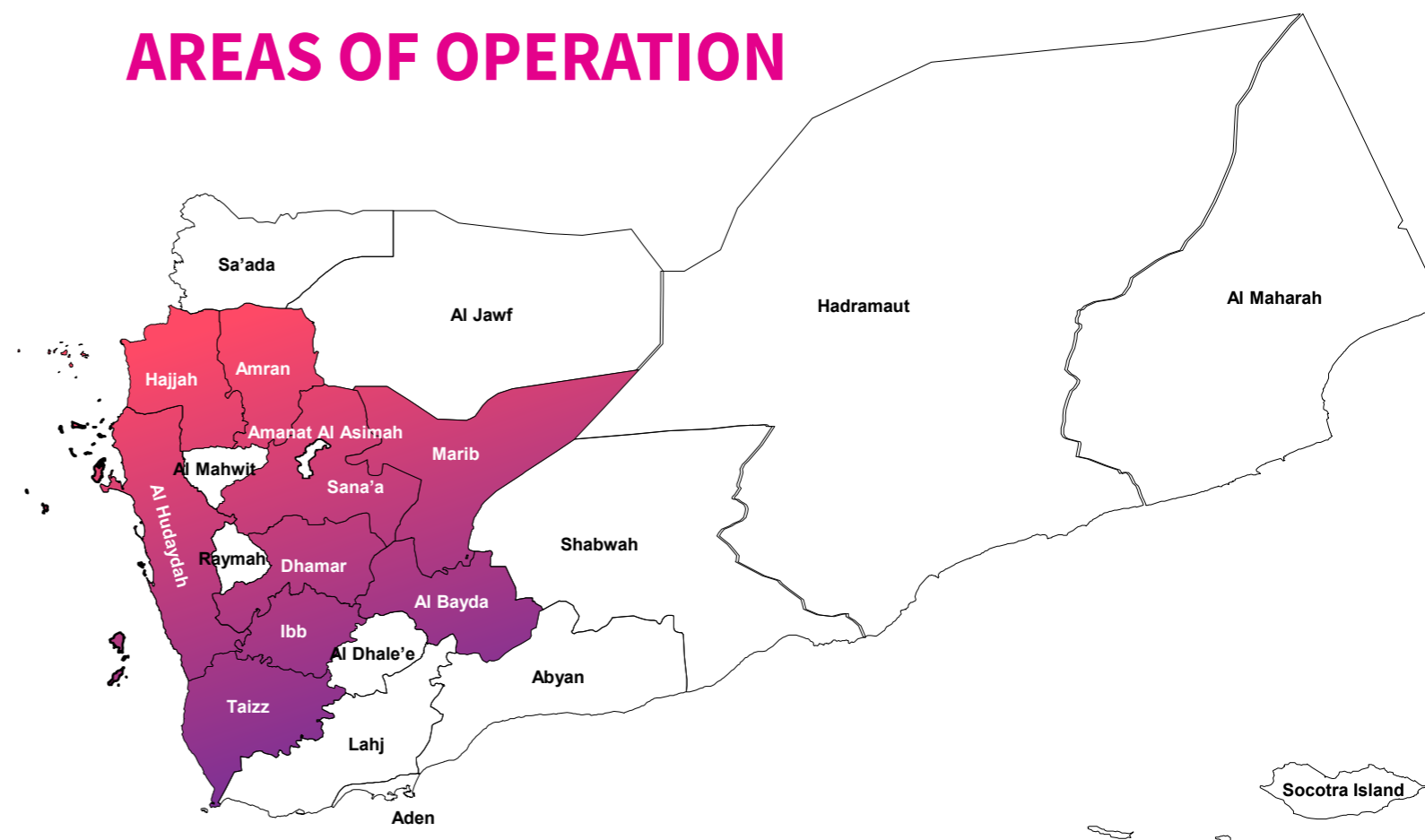

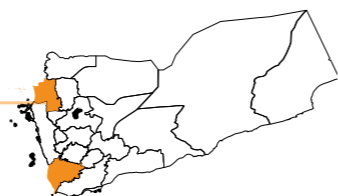

## NUTRITION

During the reporting period, RDP, supported by WFP, distributed nutritional supplements to a number of 5,852 children under 2 and 3,578 PLW to prevent the chronic and acute malnutrition in Mustaba district of Hajjah governorate. Besides, RDP has conducted awareness-raising sessions in targeted district to promote appropriate feeding for infants and young children which help increase their chances of survival as well as optimal growth, reaching almost 8,974 of population.

RDP, in collaboration with WFP, continues to treat moderately acutely malnourished children and PLW by supporting 21 health facilities with TSFP services. A total of 1,637 children under five (748 boys – 889 girls) and a number of 1,640 PLW received therapeutic supplements (Plumpy Sup & WSB+) to help reduce child mortality in Sama & As Silw districts of Taizz governorate. In addition, RDP raised awareness among community members on health and nutrition key messages, reaching more than 1,163 pregnant and lactating women.



## FOOD SECURITY & LIVELIHOOD

RDP, in collaboration with WFP, has launched the fifth distribution round of food rations to support a total of 85,477 individuals of 12,211 HHs within the general food assistance program which aims to reduce the severely food insecurity crisis through 87 food distribution points in Al Malagim, Wald Rabi', As Sawadiya, At Taffah, and Ash Sharyah districts of Al-Bayda governorate. The general food assistance program helps beneficiaries receive monthly food rations of 50 Kgs wheat flour, 4 liters of vegetable oil, and 3.5 Kgs of lentils, providing a total amount of 697.754 MTs of food rations on a monthly basis.

Al-Hudaydah gov, RDP, in collaboration with Sign of Hope, has launched the second distribution round of conditional food assistance to support a total of 110 HHs of the neediest IDPs and host community within second phase of the integrated emergency response project for food Security, livelihood and WASH services in Al-Salam camp, Al-Maraw'ah district. The conditional-based assistance helps beneficiaries receive monthly food rations – 50 Kgs of wheat flour, 10 Kgs of rice, 10 Kgs of red beans, 8 liters of vegetable oil, 2.5 Kgs of sugar, and 0.5 Kg of salt.



## WATER, SANITATION & HYGIENE

RDP, in partnership with YHF, continues the rehabilitation works of Al-Thaluth water scheme to serve a total of 5,335 individuals with clean and potable water within the project of lifesaving and sustained WASH services in IDPs collective sites and host communities in Aslam Al-Wast sub-district, Aslam district of Hajjah gov. The rehabilitation works include pumping and distribution pipelines, rehabilitation of tower concrete tank, construction of 20 HHs latrines, installation of distribution boxes, supply of solar energy, and construction of the pumping room, achieving 95% of the overall rehabilitation works.



Ku'aydinah, Hajjah, RDP, in partnership with Yemen Humanitarian Fund (YHF), has trained 20 community volunteers (15 men – 5 women) on community mobilization, hygiene-related-messages, and cholera outbreak to spread awareness and improve hygiene practices among the IDPs and most vulnerable people within the lifesaving WASH emergency response project. In addition, sixteen individuals (12 men – 4 women) of the project staff were given a training on the accountability to affected population (AAP) and disability inclusion to ensure project team has gained maximum knowledge of how to practice AAP as well as disability inclusion in WaSH activities.



During Sep, RDP has supported flood-affected people in 5 IDPs sites in Qutba & Al-Wast sub-districts of Abs district by installing 6 water points, having daily access to 397 m3 of safe drinking water (water trucking), distributing 206 basic hygiene kits, and constructing 10 emergency latrines within the urgent scale-up of emergency WASH flood-response preparedness activities for IDPs and vulnerable host communities in Hajjah and Hudaydah governorates, funded by YHF.
