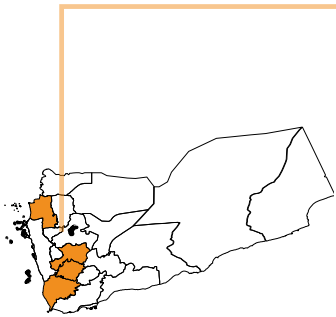

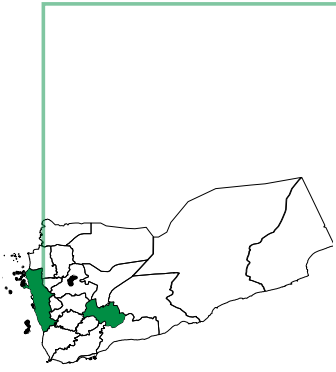
Providing MAM Treatment to Children U5 and PLW in Taizz Governorate: RDP continues to treat moderately acutely malnourished children and PLW by supporting 17 health facilities with TSFP services. A total of 1,048 children under five disaggregated as (551 boys, 497 girls) and a number of 977 PLW disaggregated as (516 pregnant, 461 lactating) received therapeutic supplements (Plumpy Sup & WSB+) to help reduce child mortality in Sama & As Silw districts of Taizz governorate. In addition, RDP raised awareness among community members on health and nutrition key messages, reaching more than 991 pregnant and lactating women.



Lessening Acute Malnutrition through Blanket Supplementary Feeding Program in Ibb, Taizz, Dhamar and Hajjah Governorates: RDP, by the generous support of WFP, continues to distribute nutritional supplements to a number of 120,684 children under 2 and 144,082 PLW to prevent the chronic and acute malnutrition in 16 targeted districts (Far Al Udayn, Al Udayn, Hazm Al Udayn, Mudhaykhirah, Al Qafr, Sama, As Silw, Shara'b Ar Rawnah, Shara'b As Salam, Jabal Ash Sharaq, Dawran Aness, Wusab Al Ali, Wusab As Safil, Khayran Al Muharraaq, Mustaba, and Washhah) of Ibb, Taizz, Dhamar and Hajjah governorates. RDP also has conducted 9,617 awareness-raising sessions to promote appropriate feeding for infants and young children which help increase their chances of survival as well as optimal growth, reaching almost 167,141 of population.

Reducing the Severely Food Insecurity Crisis for Conflict Affected People in Al-Bayda Governorate:

RDP, in collaboration with WFP, continues to distribute 654.356 Metric Tons (MTs) of food baskets to 53,405 individuals of 7,630 most affected HHs within the general food distribution program (GFD) through 50 food distribution points scattered over Al Malagim, Wald Rabi, and As Sawadiya districts. The GFD program reduces the severely food insecurity crisis and helps people put food on the table among conflict affected communities, where each household receives 75 kg of wheat flour, 5 kg of pulses, 2.5 kg of sugar, 0.5 kg of salt and 8 liters of vegetable oil on every second month.

Enabling Most Vulnerable Households to Meet Their Basic Food Needs in Al-Hudaydah Governorate:

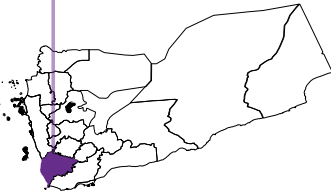
RDP, in partnership with Hoffnungszeichen, provides life-saving emergency food assistance to 91 most vulnerable food insecure households to help them meet their basic food needs on a monthly basis. In October, RDP launched the fourth distribution round of food vouchers to a total number of 741 individuals (91 HHs) of crisis-affected IDPs within the emergency food security and livelihood project in Bajil district of Al-Hudaydah governorate. Each household received 50 Kgs of wheat flour, 20 Kgs of rice, 10 Kgs of red beans, 8 liters of vegetable oil, 2.5 Kgs of sugar, and 0.5 Kg of salt after the prolonged suffering of food insecurity in that area.

Increasing Resilience of Severely Food Insecure Families in Al-Hudaydah Governorate:

Livestock are important assets for vulnerable communities which contribute to poverty reduction, sustainability of food, income, and as a store of wealth – safety net – in times of need. To increase the resilience of severely food insecure families, RDP, in partnership with Hoffnungszeichen, provides livestock to women-headed households of crisis-affected IDPs within the emergency food security and livelihood project in Bajil district of Al-Hudaydah governorate. During October, RDP supported 23 displaced HHs headed by women with a flock of sheep (69 rams, ewes, and lambs), built barns to protect the livestock, and brought tones of fodder to feed the livestock for three months.

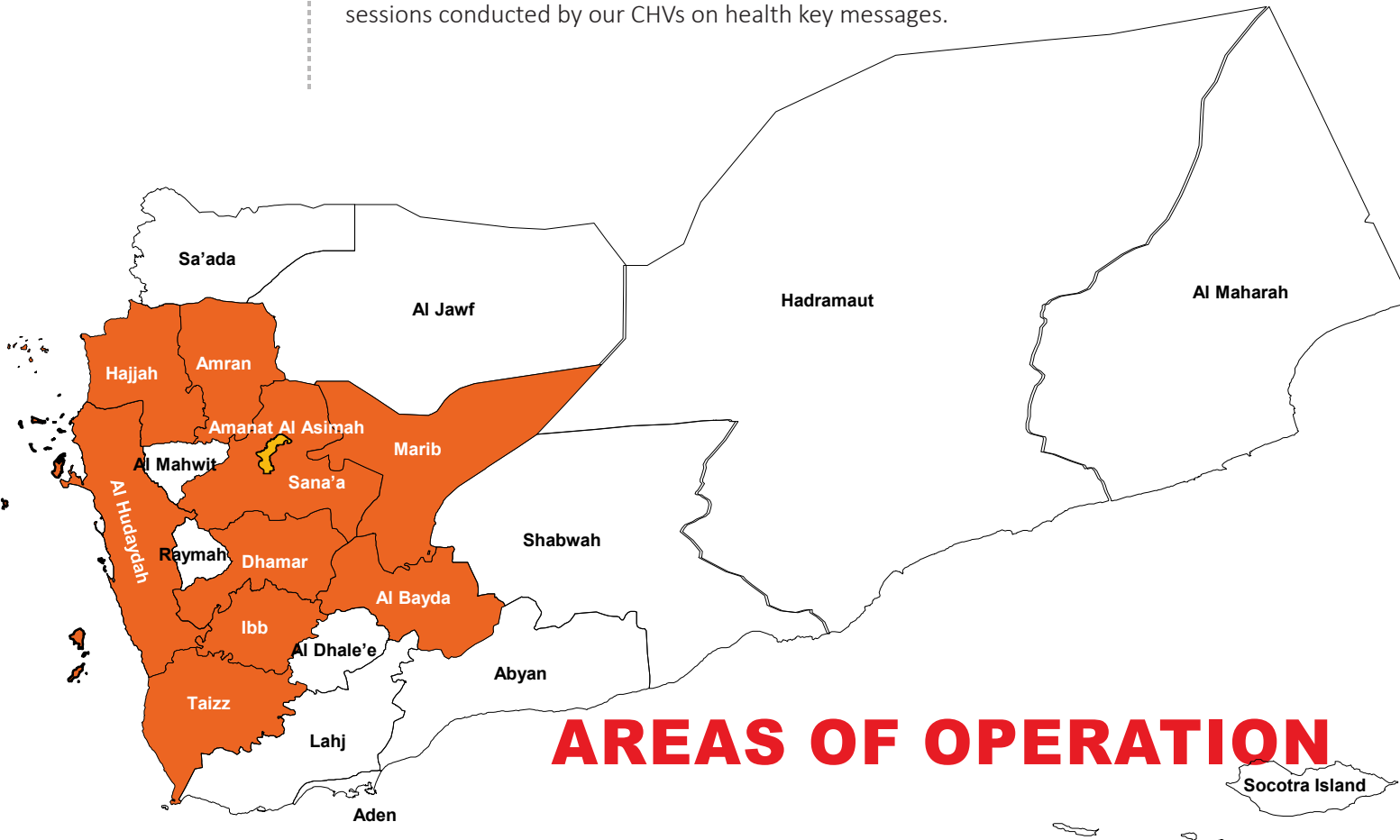

Increasing Access of Vulnerable People to Vital Health Services in Taizz Governorate:

RDP continues to provide essential healthcare services within the emergency minimum service package project (MSP), funded by Yemen Humanitarian Fund (YHF), in five health facilities (Al Thawra, Al Qatin, Al Akaysha, Al Farooq, and Al Aqsa). During October, RDP served 579 reproductive health cases (536 ANC, 43 ND/PNC), vaccinating 313 children and providing medical consultations to 5,272 individuals in five health facilities, As Silw district, Taizz governorate. Through outreach activities, RDP has been able to reach a number of 1,978 individuals within the second and third catchment areas, including vulnerable IDPs in collective sites. Additionally, 8,179 individuals were benefitted from the awareness sessions conducted by our CHVs on health key messages.
