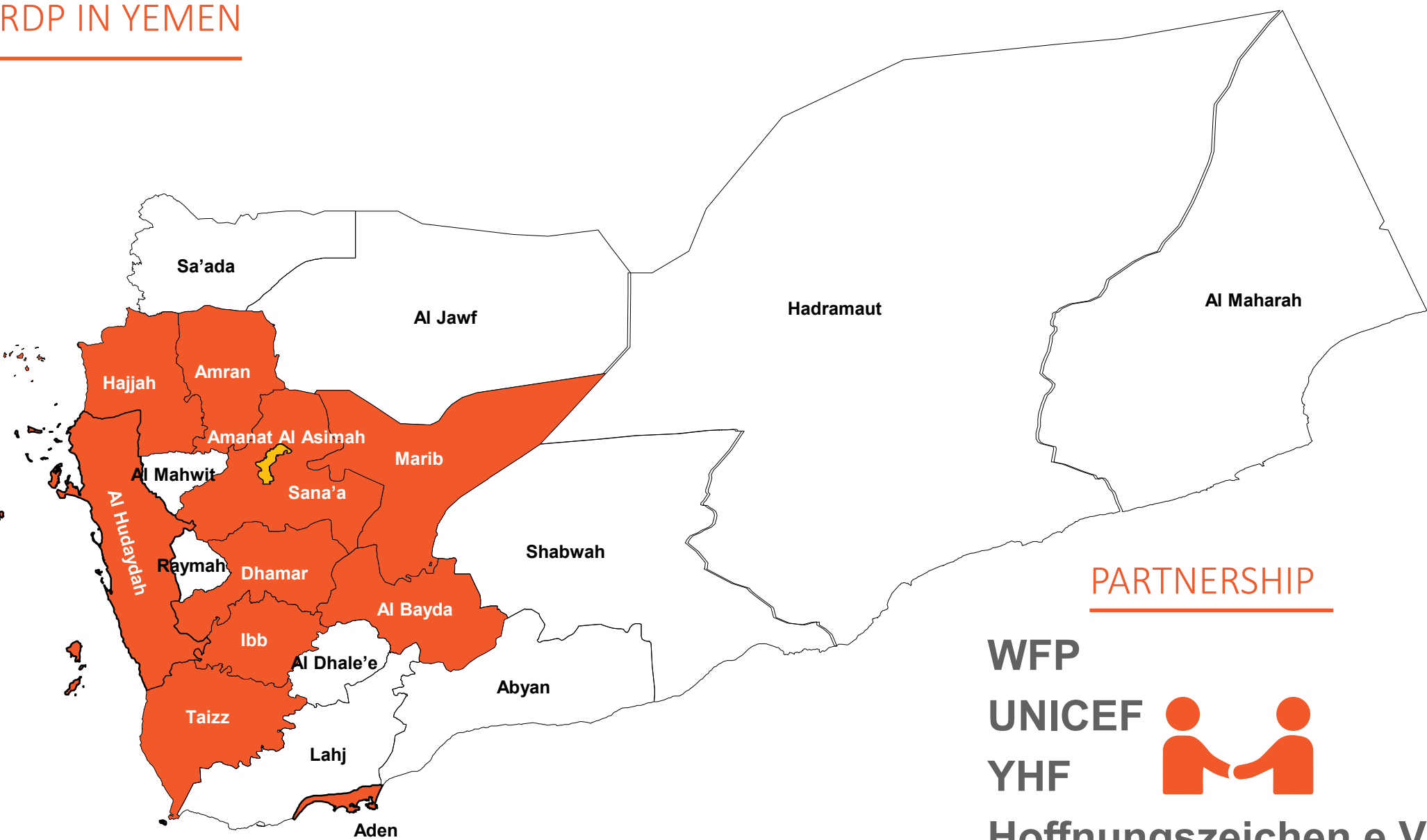

# FEBRUARY HIGHLIGHTS

1. RDP ensures that food insecure families in hard-to-reach areas have adequate access to food rations.

## RDP ensures that food insecure families in hard-to-reach areas have adequate access to food rations

RDP continues to distribute food baskets within the General Food Assistance (GFA) project funded by WFP to benefit a total number of 53,405 individuals disaggregated (21,364 men, 22,219 women, 4,807 boys, 5,021-girls) in 3 districts (Wald Rabi, Al Malagim, and As Sawadiya) of Al-Bayda Governorate. In addition, RDP has recently added the IDPs group in which 58 vulnerable households were included to the general food distribution in the same districts.

## Providing 750 individuals with safety tools to minimize work injuries when doing hard labor

RDP disbursed a total amount of \$7,000 for the safety tools and materials to maintain the high standards of safety when doing hard labor and minimize the work injuries for 750 individuals. The distributed safety tools included safety helmet, leather gloves, site jackets and boots. 328 individuals are working in seven sites of rural roads rehabilitation, 239 laborers are working in two sites of agricultural terraces and lands rehabilitation, 33 individuals are working in the protection wall of the IDPs and 150 workers are working in the construction of 100 family latrines.

## RDP increases the number of targeted households by listing 66 more in cash assistance in Khairan Al-Muharraq district of Hajjah Governorate

In addition to the conditional cash assistance which 764 households are benefitted from, RDP has added 66 vulnerable households to be provided with monthly cash assistance within cash for work program as a result of the increasing exchange rate of USD. These households will receive unconditional cash assistance for two rounds as they are headed by women and people with disabilities (60 HHS headed by women and 6 HHS headed by people with disabilities) in Gharbi Al Khamisayn sub district of Khairan Al-Muharraq district, Hajjah Governorate.

## 764 workers receive their cash vouchers for the third round of conditional cash transfer assistance in Hajjah Governorate

On March 4th, 2020, the beneficiaries of the integrated emergency response project gathered to receive their conditional cash assistance vouchers from the project distribution team and directly headed to the Alnajm for exchange to get their money. A number of 764 workers received an amount of 45,000 Yemeni Rials. The distribution of cash voucher continued till March 6th in Gharbi Al Khamisayn sub-district of Khairan Al Muharraq district.



## Achieving 65% of the total construction works of 100 HHs latrines in Khairan Al Muharraq district of Hajjah Governorate

Within cash for work activities (construction of cesspits, HHs latrines, roads rehabilitation, and protection walls for the agricultural lands and IDPs camps), RDP WASH team has achieved 65% of the total construction works of 100 HHs latrines to provide easy access to a better use of latrines in Khairan Al Muharraq district of Hajjah Governorate.



## Rehabilitating health facilities improves the range and quality of health care services

RDP WASH teams continue the rehabilitation of 40 health facilities to improve the quality of health care services. The teams intensified the rehabilitation works (water supply systems, sanitation systems (latrines, cesspits), hygiene facilities and medical wastage disposal systems for 24 health facilities - 9 HFs in Dhamar, 8 HFs in Al-Bayda and 7 HFs in Marib Governorates.



## Training 20 members of community volunteers on community mobilization and hygiene best practices

Our WASH team conducted a training workshop for 20 community volunteers (15 men and 5 women) on community mobilization, hygiene awareness messages and hygiene practices to affected HHs. The 20 community volunteers have conducted 86 awareness, community engagement and mobilization sessions for 3913 individuals ( 945 men, 452 women, 1426 boys, and 1090 girls) on key hygiene, WASH related diseases, water treatment methods and health messages in Gharbi Al Khamisayn sub-district of Khairan Al Muharraq district.



## Assessing water supplies, sanitation and hygiene facilities and medical waste disposal in 150 HF's

Of 263 health facilities, RDP in partnership with UNICEF has successfully assessed the full extent of the damage, water supplies, sanitation and hygiene facilities and medical waste disposal in 150 HF's over five governorates, 70 in Dhamar, 39 in Amran, 19 in Al Bayda, 17 in Marib and 5 in Sana'a.

## NUTRITION PROGRAM

### 70 MTs of Plumpy Doz and 327 MTs of WSB+ (soya) were distributed to hundreds of thousands of children and PLW

A total number of 47,522 children under 2 receive over 70 MTs of Plumpy Doz on a monthly basis while an achieved total number of 54,393 PLW are provided with more than 327 MTs of WSB+ (soya) through 236 food distribution points (FDPs) and 708 community nutrition volunteers in 7 districts - Far Al-Udayn, Al-Udayn, Hazm Al-Udayn, Mudhaikhera, Al Qafr, Same and As Silw - of Ibb and Taizz Governorates.

### Treatment of MAM for malnourished children aged 6-59 months and PLW through our supported health facilities

A number of 380 CU5 and 233 PLW have been served with nutritional commodities (Plumpy sup and WSB+) through 6 targeted health facilities in As Silw and Sama districts of Taizz Governorate. Besides, our CNVs reached a number of 630 individuals disaggregated (420 women, 130 boys, 80 girls) through awareness-raising campaigns.

## Supporting the general public through effective means of communication on nutrition key messages

RDP CNVs have educated a total of 54,034 individuals disaggregated (4,568 men, 16,709 pregnant women, 18,141 lactating women, 14,616 other women) through awareness raising campaigns in 7 districts (Far Al Udayn, Al Udayn, Hazm Al Udayn, Mudhaikhera, Al Qafr, Same, As Silw) of Ibb and Taizz Governorates.



## HEALTH PROGRAM

### 4,715 individuals are provided with health care through 3 supported health facilities in Al Qafr district of Ibb Governorate

RDP-supported 3 health facilities (Madahajayn, Al-Mabda, Al-Karaba) served 188 reproductive health cases as (168 ANC, 20 ND, 20 PNC), vaccinated 79 children, treated 184 suspected cholera cases in ORCs (10 men, 20 women, 97 boys, 57 girls), given medical consultations to 4,264 individuals (835 men, 1,389 women, 1,020 boys, 1,020 girls) in Al Qafr district of Ibb Governorate.
