JULY HIGHLIGHTS

NUTRITION:

- A total of 141 children U5 and 214 pregnant and lactating women are provided with TSFP services in two districts of Taizz Governorate.
- The expansion of BSFP program is bound to make all the difference for communities whose children are susceptible to malnutrition.

WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE:

- Starting the rehabilitation works for the two water schemes in Bani saif Al-Safel and Bani Mubariz sub-districts in Al-Qafr district.
- Distribution of hygiene kits to 3,970 individuals of IDPs to improve hygiene practices among the community in Khayran Al-Muharraq district.
- Training water management committees and building their capacity to manage the water networks in Ibb and Hajjah governorates.

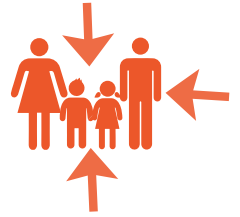
HEALTH:

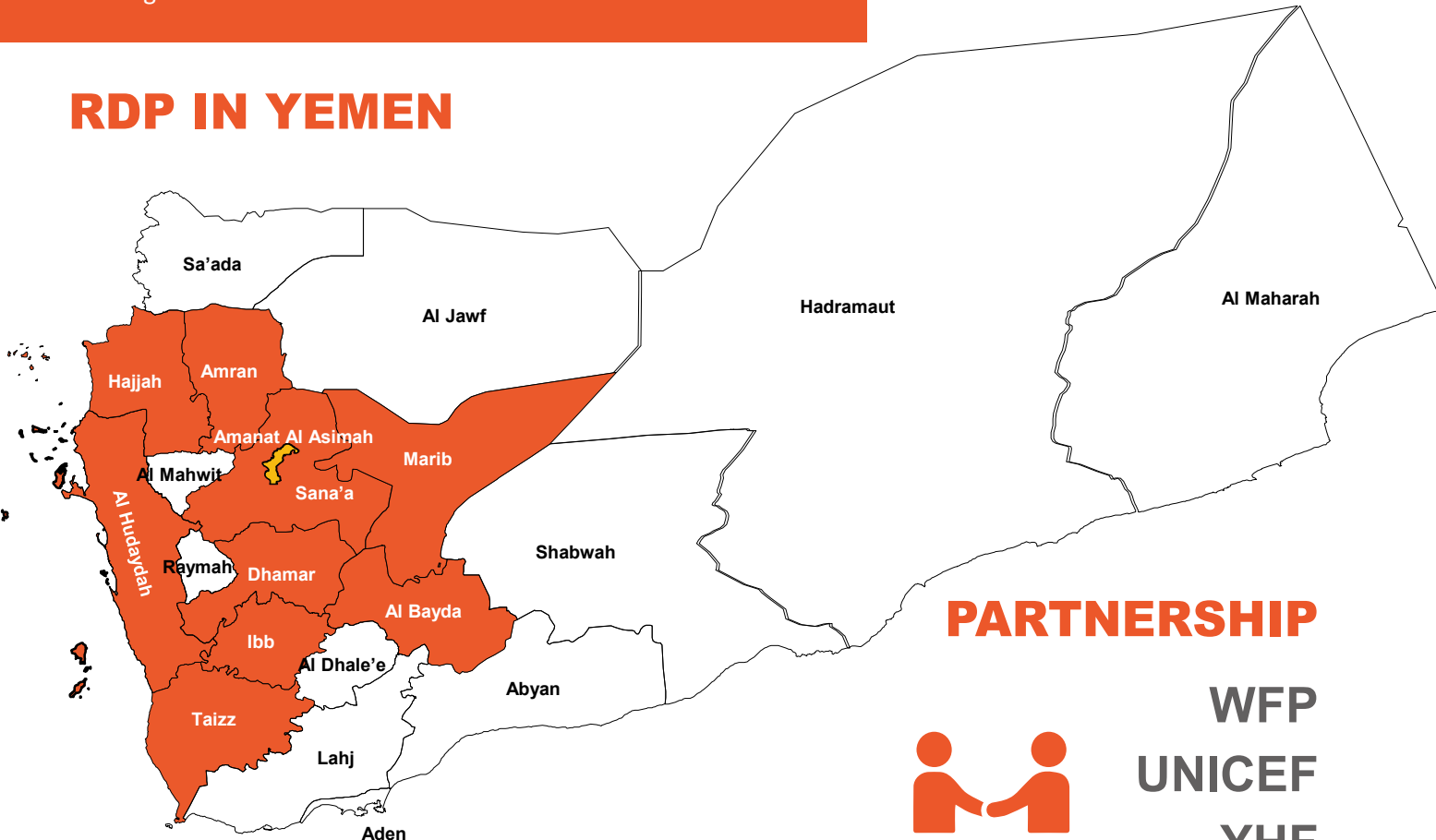

A number of 754 individuals were benefited from the healthcare services in Al Abdiyah district of Marib governorate

Through the Emergency MSP Project funded by YHF, RDP health workers in Al-Khalila health facility have served 69 reproductive health cases (63 ANC, 6 ND/PNC), vaccinated 65 children and provided medical consultations to 620 individuals (139 men, 191 women, 146 boys, 144 girls) in Al Abdiyah district of Marib Gov. Additionally, 488 individuals were benefitted from the awareness sessions conducted by our CHVs on health key messages.

44,954 individuals were reached through door-to-door awareness-raising campaigns for COVID-19-related-messages in 8 districts of Ibb, Taizz, and Marib governorates

In July, RDP, with the support of Hoffnungszeichen, distributed 40 Infra-red thermometers to CHVs to be used for temperature screening and continued to conduct door-to-door awareness-raising campaigns for COVID-19-related-messages, reaching 44,954 individuals (14,366 men, 15,778 women, 7,329 boys, 7,481 girls) in Al-Udayn, Far AlUdayn, Hazm AlUdayn, Mudhiakhira, Al-Qafr, Sama, As Silw, and Al Abdyiah districts of Ibb, Taizz, and Marib governorates.

The expansion of BSFP program is bound to make all the difference for communities whose children are susceptible to malnutrition

Based on WFP distribution standards in the context of COVID-19, RDP completed June distribution cycle by distributing single ration of P.doz to a total of 56,412 children U2 and the remaining quantities of WSB+ to a number of 761 PLW in Al-Udayn, Far AlUdayn, Hazm AlUdayn, Mudhiakhira, Al-Qafr, Sama, and As Silw districts of Ibb & Taizz governorates.

As for the new BSFP intervention, our team has ensured full preparation of the new food distribution points together with warehouses, and the selection of community nutrition volunteers before the first distribution round of BSFP in Shara'ab As Salam, Shara'ab Ar Rownah, Jabal Al-Sharq, Dhowran Aness, Wusab Al-Safil, Wusab Al-Ali, Khayran Al-Muharraaq, Mustaba, and Washaha districts of Taizz, Dhamar, and Hajjah governorates.

A total of 141 children U5 and 214 pregnant and lactating women are provided with TSFP services in two districts of Taizz Governorate

RDP, supported by WFP, continues to deliver nutritional supplements for moderately acutely malnourished children and pregnant and lactating women through 9 supported health facilities in Sama and As Silw districts of Taizz governorate. During July, a number of 141 CU5 and 214 PLW were served with Plumpy sup and WSB+. Besides, our CNVs reached a number of 501 individuals disaggregated (84 men, 417 women) through awareness-raising campaigns in the targeted districts.

RDP started the rehabilitation works for the two water schemes in Bani saif Al-Safel and Bani Mubariz sub-districts to ensure easy access to clean & safe water within the WASH response project in Khayran Al Muharraq district of Hajjah governorate and Al Qafr district of Ibb governorate, supported by YHF. The construction works such as building the foundation of solar panel continues despite the torrential rain.

Training water management committees and building their capacity to manage the water networks in Ibb and Hajjah governorates

In July, RDP WASH team conducted training workshops for 30 members (20 men, 10 women) of water management committees (WMCs) to build their capacity for managing the three water networks in Bani saif Al-Safel, Bani Mubariz, and Masrooh sub-districts of Al-Qafr and Khayran Al Muharraq districts, Ibb and Hajjah governorates.

Distribution of hygiene kits to 3,970 individuals of IDPs to improve hygiene practices among the community in Khayran Al-Muharraq district

In July, RDP distributed basic/consumable hygiene kits received as in-kind from UNICEF to 522 HHs of 3,970 individuals of IDPs disaggregated as (778 men , 810 women , 1,166 boys and 1,216 girls), aiming to improve hygiene practices among the community in Masrooh sub-district of Khayran Al-Muharraq district, Hajjah Gov.
