NUTRITION

Delivering nutritional supplements to 98,156 children under 2 and 99,730 PLW in 12 districts of lbb, Taizz, and Hajjah governorates.

Providing therapeutic supplements to treat more than 2,191 MAM cases in Sama & Al Silw districts of Taizz governorate.



HEALTH

Providing life-saving medical assistance to 15,306 individuals in As Silw district of Taizz governorate.



NUTRITION

TSFP:

In Taizz, RDP continues to treat moderately acutely malnourished children and PLW by supporting 17 health facilities with TSFP services. A total of 1,197 children under five disaggregated as (591 boys, 606 girls) and a number of 994 PLW disaggregated as (575 pregnant, 419 lactating) received therapeutic supplements (Plumpy Sup & WSB+) to help reduce child mortality in Sama & Al Silw districts of Taizz governorate. In addition, RDP raised awareness among community members on health and nutrition key messages, reaching more than 1,095 pregnant and lactating women.



BSFP:

In Ibb, Taizz, Dhamar and Hajjah Govs, RDP is constantly working to prevent the widespread of acute malnutrition among those at-risk by distributing hundreds of metric tons of BSFP commodities through 657 food distribution sites. RDP's 1,971 community nutrition volunteers distributed nutritional supplements to a number of 98,156 children under 2 and 99,730 PLW to prevent the chronic and acute malnutrition in 12 targeted districts (Far Al Udayn, Al Udayn, Hazm Al Udayn, Mudhaykhirah, Al Qafr, Sama, As Silw, Shara'b Ar Rawnah, Shara'b As Salam, Khayran Al Muharraq, Mustaba, Washhah) of Ibb, Taizz, and Hajjah governorates. RDP also carried out 7,423 awareness-raising sessions to promote appropriate feeding for infants and young children which help increase their chances of survival as well as optimal growth, reaching almost 111,355 of population.






In Al Bayda governorate, RDP continues to distribute 651.789 Metric Tons (MTs) of food baskets to 53,405 individuals of 7,630 most affected HHs within the general food distribution program (GFD), supported by WFP, through 50 food distribution points scattered over Al Malagim, Wald Rabi, and As Sawadiya districts. Each household received 75 kg of wheat flour, 5 kg of pulses, 2.5 kg of sugar, 0.5 kg of salt and 8 liters of vegetable oil.





In Taizz governorate, RDP provides life-saving medical assistance within the emergency minimum service package project (MSP), funded by YHF, in five health facilities (Al Thawra, Al Qabiluh, Al Akaysha, Al Farooq, and Al Aqsa) in As Silw district. RDP served 496 reproductive health cases (477 ANC, 19 ND/PNC), vaccinating 408 children and providing medical consultations to 5,055 individuals. The mobile team conducted 9 outreach activities to reach a number of 935 individuals within the second and third catchment areas in As Silw district of Taizz Gov. Additionally, 8,412 individuals were benefitted from the awareness sessions conducted by our CHVs on health key messages.

WATER, SANITATION & HYGIENE

Unlike traditional hand-pumps, solar-powered systems can vastly enhance the quality of water services, improving the health, development, safety and livelihoods of children and their families. Therefore, RDP has conducted a five-day training workshop on solar-powered water systems – design, installation, operation and maintenance – for 16 WaSH engineers to improve their technical capacity on solar water systems.
